Water Rate Adjustment Scheduled for October 1, 2009



In August 2009 the Wyandotte Municipal Service Commission adopted a water rate adjustment. For an average residential water customer the monthly charge will increase \$0.60 from \$17.82 to \$8.42. This increase reflects an increase of \$.10/Kgal, from \$1.07 to \$1.17. This increase is due to new regulatory requirements and commodity price increases. Even with these increases, Wyandotte's consumers still enjoy some of the area's lowest water rates. 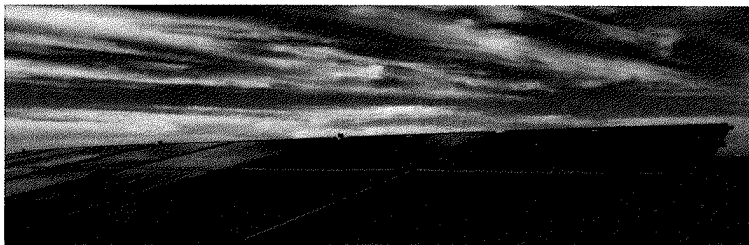
Energy Saving Programs

Wyandotte Municipal Services launches the first of its new energy-saving programs, designed to help our customers lower their energy use and save money. Recent state law requires that all Michigan utilities undertake "energy optimization" plans to assist customers in reducing their energy costs. In order to fund these programs the law requires WMS to assess a monthly surcharge. The charge for an average customer will be \$0.89 per month.

Recycle your old refrigerator or freezer – If you are a Wyandotte Municipal customer with an older working refrigerator or freezer (in your garage or basement, for example), you can take advantage of this program. We'll come pick it up for FREE. You'll get a \$30 check, and we'll recycle it in an environmentally proper way.

Commercial and Industrial Incentive Programs –Wyandotte Municipal Services offer cash incentive to businesses to help cover the cost of a variety of energy-efficient upgrades (lighting and variable speed drives for example).

Cold Weather Energy Saving Tips

Use sunlight wisely. Leave shades and blinds open during sunny, cold days, but close them at night to reduce the amount of heat lost through windows.

Caulk and weather-strip. Don't just seal doors and windows. Look for other air leaks that you can seal, such as around plumbing penetrations, air ducts of ceiling-mounted lighting fixtures.

Replace or clean your furnace filters monthly. This could save up to 5% on your heating bill.

Insulate your hot water heater and hot water pipes. Follow the manufacture's instructions or get professional help.
