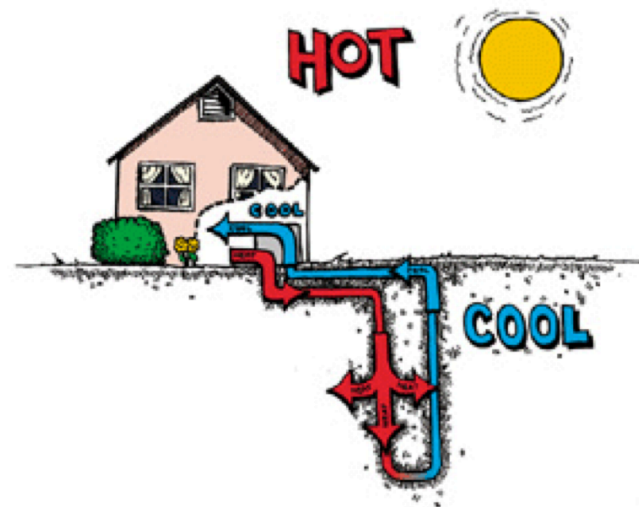

- Contact IGSHPA certified HVAC contractors to obtain quotes on the GSHP and horizontal connection and bore field drilling; multiple quotes will allow for competitive costing.
- Have contractor perform energy saving economics and ROI analysis.
- Once the decision to install a Geothermal system has been made, the homeowner needs to email geothermal@wyan.org with the proposed location of the bore field for approval.
- Install vertical bore heat exchanger
